Great Aussie Bush Camp – Years 2-6

This year our major school camp will be held the first week in Term 4 at the Great Aussie Bush Camp at Tea Gardens. The Great Aussie Bush Camp delivers outdoor recreation-based teaching and learning outcomes in a beautiful natural setting, with a great range of fantastic activities on offer.

The camp fee is \$266.20 per student however much of this cost will be subsidised with the actual cost to parents being \$150.00 per attending student. To make it easier for families, we are offering payment plans as below. Please contact the office with any queries.

Payment plan options:

- \$10/week for 15 weeks, paid in full by the end of Term 3.
- 3 instalments of \$50 – the first \$50 paid by the end of Term 2, another \$50 at the beginning of Term 3, and a final \$50 to be paid by the end of Term 3.
- A one-off payment in full of \$150 before the end of Term 3.

The P&C has tartan girls Winter pants available in sizes 4, 6, 8, 10, and 12. All are reduced to just \$10.00 per pair.


Don't forget there are a number of pre-loved uniform items in a range of sizes for just the cost of a gold coin donation.
